The 2012-13 Board strove to provide the League and the community with a well-rounded array of programs. The League began the year with a panel discussion on the Arkansas Medical Marijuana Act that came before voters in the 2012 November election. Four candidate forums were held for local and state offices. Other programs included presentations on school safety, reports on the city from the Mayor and the Chief of Police, Arkansas highways, the Dream Act, Our Changing Political Climate, a plea for continuing a Sebastian county sales tax, a 2013 Legislative Update from two State Representatives, a panel discussion on the disadvantaged in our community, and a report from a League member on her American Women's History Tour.

On September 25, 2012, League members participated in a voter registration drive in two locations in conjunction with National Voter Registration Day. We also funded a local student to attend Girls' State.
